

Road Trip! Bring on the Buckeyes!



Penn State men's hockey team will play at Ohio State on Saturday, January 7, 2017. The Friends of Penn State Men's Hockey (FOPSMH) is planning an overnight trip to attend this game.

We will leave State College on Saturday morning, and return to State College Sunday afternoon. The cost of the bus will be \$85 per person for 2016-2017 members, \$100 for non-members. (If you are not a member, or have not renewed last year's membership, you can find an application on fopsmh.org). This price includes the bus, bus driver tip, transfers between the hotel and the arena, and GAME TICKET. MEAL COSTS ARE NOT INCLUDED IN THIS PRICE. We're also considering an optional pre-game meal at Schmidt's German Restaurant in the German Village section of Columbus.
